It even allows you to switch between low, passenger-access mode and an off-road mode that raises the ground clearance by 2 inches.

Inside the cabin, adults in all three rows will find ample space, complemented by the abundance of cargo room, a trait rarely matched by competitors. The user-friendly infotainment system adds to the overall appeal.

While some may argue that more car-like three-row crossover SUVs might be easier to drive and offer better fuel economy, the 2021 Yukon stands tall, proving itself fully competitive with the top-notch Ford Expedition. With powerful V8 engines, a cushioned ride, and commendable gas mileage for its class, the GMC Yukon emerges as an outstanding large SUV, redefining expectations in its category.
